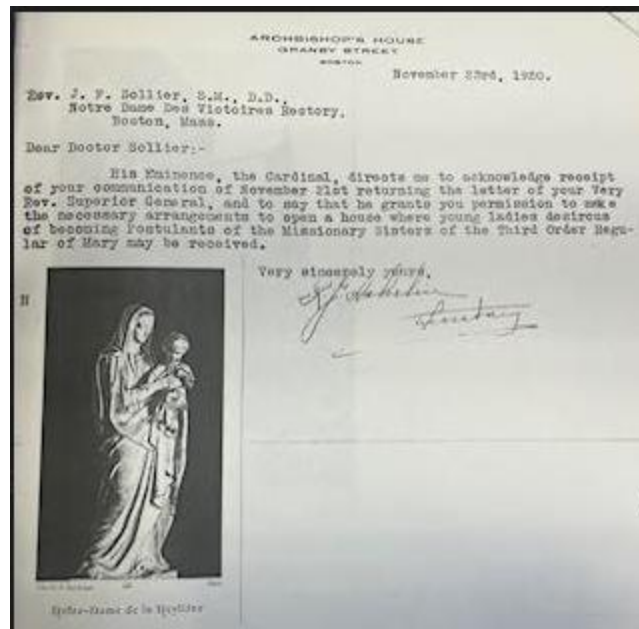

### **Biography/Historical Note**

This collection, Marist Missionary Sisters History Collection, is organized numerically at folder level, with attendant descriptions for each item. The contents of each individual file are unique, but the collection overall presents a wide-ranging compilation of historical documents pertaining to the Missionary Sisters of the Society of Mary, from the founding of the congregation to the early twenty-first century. The collection includes records concerning the origins of the order; correspondence, memoirs, manuscripts, publications, articles; spiritual, devotional and prayer guides; unique records pertaining to specific regional provinces; congregational records, constitution and legislative documents; profiles and biographies. ### **Collection Scope and Content Note**

The Marist Missionary Sisters History Collection maintains a wide-ranging compilation of records pertaining to the history of the Missionary Sisters of the Society of Mary. The inclusive time-span reflected in these records is 1803-2014, encompassing historical records concerning the opening and closing of houses, originary constitutional, congregational and legislative documents; correspondence, emails, memoirs, manuscripts, publications, articles, translations; spiritual,

devotional and prayer guides, profiles, biographies, obituaries; directories, lectures, notes, hand-drawn maps. The collection is organized in 19 boxes, 7.92 linear feet, with folder-level detail regarding all items.

### Processing Notes

Metal clips and staples were removed from materials—provided that this removal did not damage original documents—and folded items were flattened. All materials are assembled in acid-free, unsealed, labeled envelopes, foldered and/or bound, and collected in archival boxes. Original envelopes of all correspondence, notes and documents were preserved. The finding aid contents list is organized by box identifier and file numbers, with content descriptions and (if necessary) additional notes for each item. Four addenda (labeled with corresponding asterisks) were appended as content indices to the following items: \*Addendum 1 Box HIS1-AV(i), File 1; \*\*Addendum 2 Box HIS2B-AV(i), File 2; \*\*\*Addendum 3 Box HIS6-AV(ii), File 16; \*\*\*\* Addendum 4 Box HIS14-AV(iii), File 9.
